

GENE ROTH SCHOLARSHIP- 2019

Eligibility Requirements- Applicant *must* be:

1. A direct descendent or stepchild of a current or deceased Veteran member of Post 28.
2. A current high school senior.
3. Planning to attend a college or post-secondary educational institution within one year after high school graduation
4. Have a commendable high school record, as reflected in curricular and extra-curricular achievement and activities.

Application Requirements- To be considered for an award:

1. Complete application ***must* be received at Post 28 on or before the Friday of the 3rd week in April.**
2. Application entries ***must* be legibly printed in blue or black ink, include an official copy of applicant's high school transcript, and be delivered to Post 28 in a sealed envelope marked, "AMERICAN LEGION GENE ROTH SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE"**

Scholarship award recipients will be announced in mid-to-late May. Upon notification of a scholarship recipient's enrollment in a qualified school or institution, a check for the scholarship award will be sent to the institution's financial aid office for deposit in the recipient's account to help cover expenses, such as for tuition and room/board.
